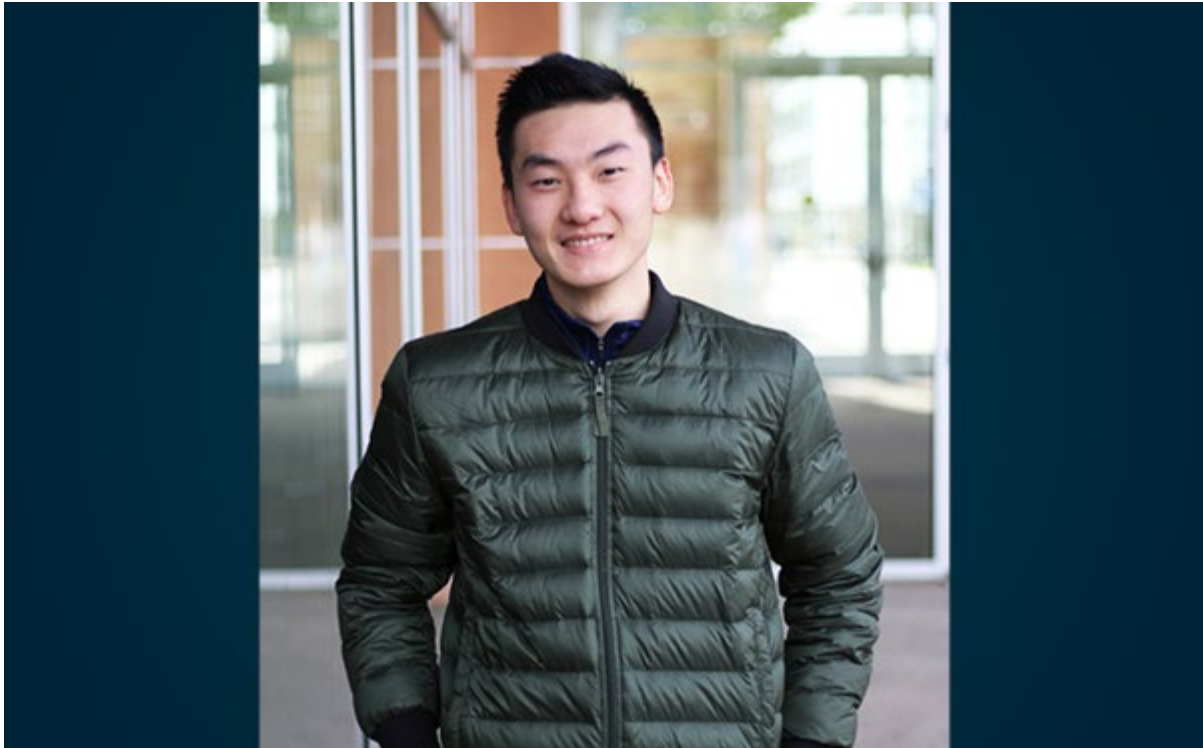
Mark Eades '79
