CSUF Alumni's Voter Education Series

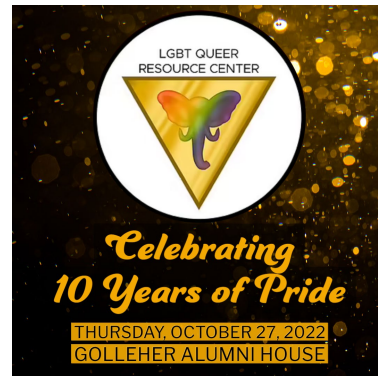
Whether you're a first-time, or seasoned voter, join us on October 19 & 26, 2022 to learn more about what to expect this election cycle as a California voter:

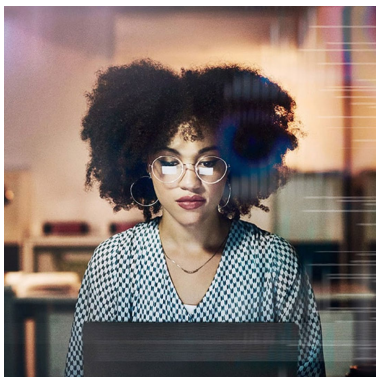
